

East Shore Road Culvert Project Information



The Town of Morris is providing Public Informational Forum for Bridge No. 86-006 concerning the Culvert, which carries East Shore Road over Whittlesey Brook in the Town of Morris,

The project is currently in the final design phase. This project consists of replacement of the existing concrete slab bridge in its entirety with a new metal pipe arch structure. The culvert is located just north of the Town Beach Drive entrance, approximately 2100-feet east of North Street (Route 109). Construction of this project is estimated to cost up to \$670,000.

The public is invited to review this information and comment. In addition, there will a public presentation of the project details on October 13, 2022 at 3:30 PM at the Morris Town Hall. Comments, questions and concerns may be submitted to the Town within 14-days of this meeting.

It is the Town's policy to keep persons informed and involved when such projects are undertaken. It is important that the community share its concerns to assist in the project's development.
